

## How to get involved with Special Interest Groups

Club-wide events are shown on the website and new event announcements are emailed to all members. However, this does not apply to activities of the Special Interest Groups. For these groups, there are three distinct situations.

- For the **Big Screen** Group, **Bicycling** Group and **Walking** Group, emails about upcoming events are only sent to “members” of those groups. To become a group member, contact the person shown on the group details page on the website.
- For the **Indoor Bowling** Group, and the **Duplicate Bridge** Group, simply show up at the regular weekly event. However, it would probably be a good idea to contact the person responsible for each group to confirm event details.
- For the **Book** Groups and the **Wine Tasting** Groups, these are “closed” groups in that there is a specific number of people in each group who meet on a regular basis. You can only join one of these groups if someone drops out of the group. Contact the person responsible for the group to indicate that you would like to be put on the waiting list for that group.

We are keen to see new Special Interest Groups created. If anyone is willing to spearhead a new group, our existing group leaders are ready and willing to assist any new group leaders.
